GENERAL RULES

The following rules are intended to provide a safe and pleasant family camping experience for you and your neighbors. We ask parents to supervise their children and inform them of these rules. Violation of these rules could mean early ejection without any refund.

- **CAMPSITE & RENTAL CHECK-OUT: 11:00AM.** Prior Arrival for late check-out if available. Additional fees may apply.
- **VISITOR REGISTRATION:** Visiting hours are 10:00AM to 10:00PM. All visitors are REQUIRED to register at the main office upon arrival. Visitors may not bring pets. Overnight visitors must register by 8:00PM and check-out no later than 10:00AM the following morning.
- **RATES BASED ON 4 PER CAMPSITE:** Additional fees apply beyond four. Limit of 8 per site, 4 of which may be adults.
- **CHILDREN MUST BE SUPERVISED:** We value our camping children. Please encourage your children to play in designated play areas. Teenagers and children must not be left unattended on campsites overnight. Parents are responsible for their children and guests at all times.
- **QUIET HOURS 10:00PM TO 8:00AM:** Please be considerate of those around you and lower the volume of radios, TVs, and voices. **STRICTLY ENFORCED.**
- **NO SMOKING AND NO PETS PERMITTED IN BUILDINGS, POOL AREA OR PLAYGROUND.**
- **PARKING:** 2 vehicles max per campsite. No parking on roadways, vegetation or vacant campsites. Overflow parking available by the office. Overnight parking is a \$5.00 fee.
- **CAMPFIRES:** All fires must be contained in fire pits provided, kept at a low level and supervised at all times. Completely extinguish fires by 11:00PM before leaving your campsite or retiring for the night.
- **FIREWOOD:** State of Maine Law requires guests and visitors to "Buy it where you burn it." No cutting of trees in the campground or adjoining properties. Firewood is sold at the office.
- **TREES & PROPERTY:** Please DO NOT cut or disfigure trees or shrubs in any way. **NO NAILS, SCREWS, OR OTHER HARDWARE IN THE TREES PERMITTED.** Please use rope or bungee cords for clotheslines to dry bathing suits and towels only.
- **TRASH & RECYCLABLES:** Place bagged trash in the dumpster by the office and recyclable cans/bottles in containers provided. **TO DETER UNINVITED ANIMALS, DO NOT LEAVE TRASH OUT OVERNIGHT.**
- **SINK (GREY) WATER:** All wastewater from camping units must be contained according to State regulations and cannot be dumped on the ground.
- **DUMP STATION/PORTABLE SANI-STATION:** Dump station is located at the entrance/exit and free to all registered campers. "Honey Wagon" pump-out is available on Mondays and Thursdays with 24 hour prior payment and request.
- **BICYCLES:** State of Maine Law requires all cyclists under the age of 16 wear bike helmets. Bikes must be parked at their campsite before dark.
- **MOTORCYCLES/MOPEDS/MINIBIKES/ATVs:** Allowed ONLY when entering and exiting the campground. Must be parked on their own site, off the road and not on vegetation when not in use.
- **NO MOTORIZED OR BATTERY OPERATED CHILDREN'S TOYS ALLOWED ON THE GROUNDS.**
- **RESTROOMS & SHOWERS OPEN 24 HOURS (Except when posted for cleaning):** To avoid accidents or injuries, all children under the age of 10 must be accompanied by an adult. **PLEASE HELP TO KEEP OUR RESTROOMS CLEAN.** Please report any issues to the office immediately.
- **LAUNDRY ROOM:** Coin-operated washers and dryers are available 24 hours. Refer to guide map for location.
- **WATER USAGE:** Washing RVs, campers, vehicles, ATVs, etc. is not permitted.
- **POOL HOURS 9:00AM TO DUSK: NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY. SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK.** Pool rules must be observed at all times. Children under the age of 14 must be accompanied by an adult when in the pool.
- **POND: NO SWIMMING OR DIVING IN POND!** No motorized boats allowed in pond.
- **RECREATION HALL HOURS 9:00AM TO 9:00PM:** Located by the pool. Please supervise children.
- **ALCOHOL:** Permitted on your campsite and should not be brought into any of our common areas. Please drink responsibly. Consumption by a minor will lead to ejection with NO REFUND.
- **PRIVACY:** Please respect the privacy and space of other campers and the owners. Use designated roadways and paths rather than walking through or between occupied sites.

Any violations of the rules or disorderly conduct that causes others to complain shall be grounds for ejection from the campground without a refund.

PET RULES

Camping with pets can be a wonderful adventure for both owners and pets

- Pets must be leashed at all times, a straight line leash no longer than 6 feet when walking or on campsite. Leash should not extend off of site in any direction.
- Pets must be walked by an adult. For the safety of all, children are not permitted to walk pets.
- Owners must clean up after their pets. Doggie Dump Stations are located on both ends of the campground for your convenience.
- Do not allow your pets to "go" on others' sites at any time.
- Pets are not permitted in any buildings, on the playground or in the pool area.
- DO NOT leave your pets unattended, anywhere - anytime; this includes in your trailer.
- Any nuisance pets (barking or crying, aggressive, etc. creating disturbance will not be tolerated and shall be requested to exit the property.

Rules are subject to change without and/or with notice to follow as soon as reasonably possible.
